The Medical Camp was conducted at Siva Durga colony in Nambur village, Guntur District and its Organizing team included 7 VRO Volunteers by Fr Dr S Emmanuel, SJ.Associate Director and Mr. Bosco, Finance Officer, VRO and 6 volunteers of JMJ Society.

1. Dr. Seetha K, (Gynaecologist) was a specialized doctor and gives the best Treatments to patients for having related issues for women's. Doctor was suggested best Medicines to patients and given guidelines for health related doubts.

Many People of Yanadi (Tribal) Community are attended to the Camp and Utilized the Services of medical camp. Nearby Place of village are also Utilized the healthcare services by Free of Cost, Our Doctors are also gives their experience range of Treatment service to the People with facilities of general check-ups, gynecological consultations, paediatric care, and general medicine consultations. The VRO also arranged for free Blood Sugar Level and Blood Pressure Tests which were hugely useful for many villagers. Undergone their General wealth Check-ups, and Benefited the Rich Medicines provided Free of Cost by VRO.



Services and Medicines Issued to Patients

- The beneficiaries of the medical camp were members of the Yanadhi community residing in Siva Durga Colony, Amedkar Nagar, Ali Rafath colony and Vijay Bhaskarnagar.
- The camp specifically aimed to reach out to women, children, and men who face financial constraints and are unable to afford treatment at private hospitals.
- The camp successfully provided much-needed medical attention and support to this underserved population.
- Few of the patients were referred by the doctors for further treatment at Raja Rajeshwari Memorial Hospital.

- The medical camp made a significant impact on the health and well-being of the Yanadhi community living in hamlets.
- Two hundred people benefited from this medical camp.
